The Cedarburg Bog system is made up of about 2200 acres that include seven or eight plant communities e.g., conifer and hardwood swamps, sedge meadow, marsh, lakes, fen, and upland forest. There is public access at the north and south ends of the bog. The UWM Field Station trails are only open to the public for group use arranged in advance or at public events.

Endangered species are illegal to disturb or collect.
